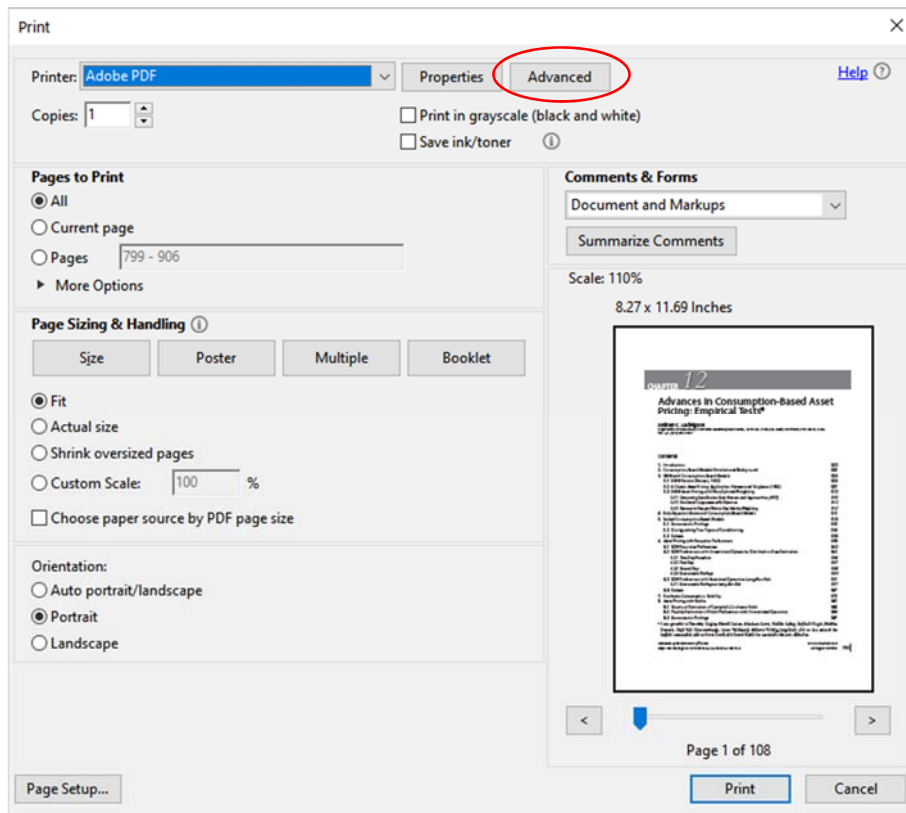


How to convert jpeg2000 Images in PDF to classical jpeg?

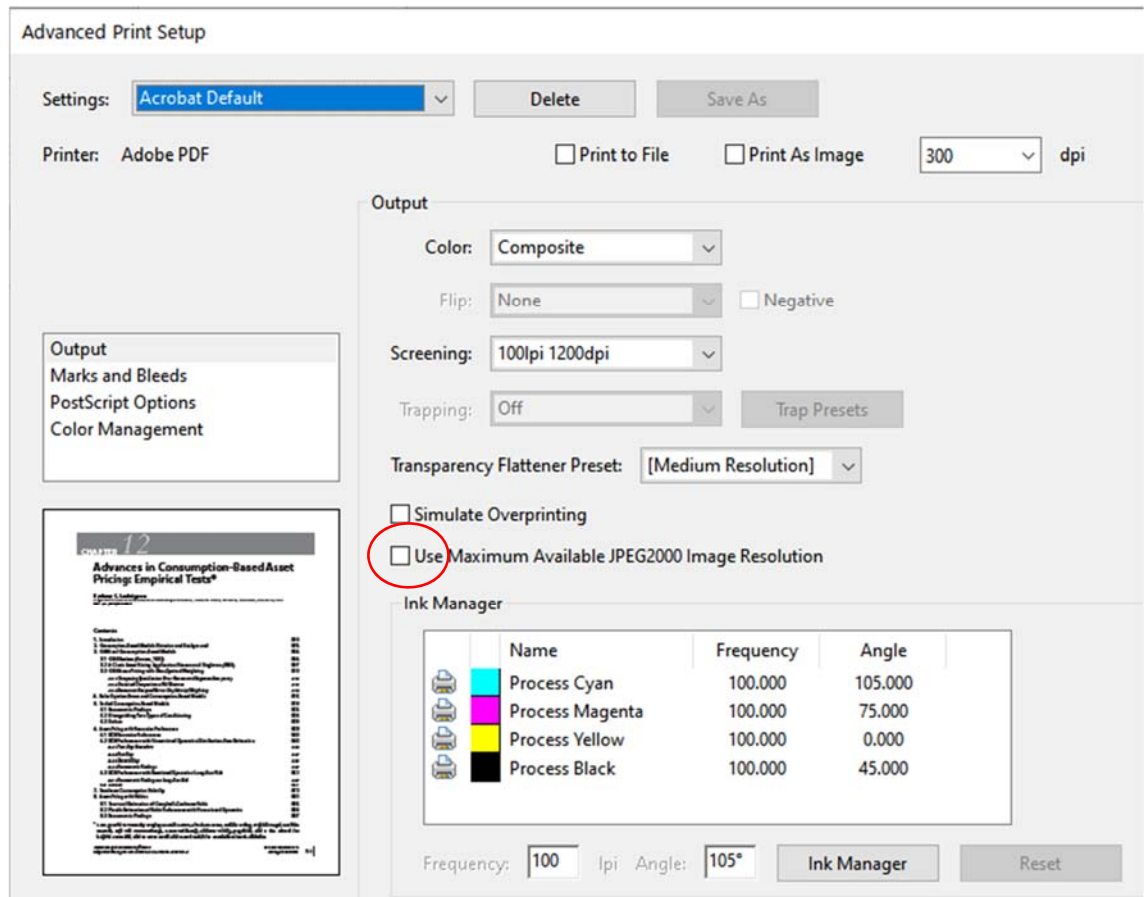
(Important Remark)

Please note that InftyReader cannot process PDF including jpeg2000 images properly. If you have such PDF, you can change the jpeg2000 images in the PDF using Adobe PDF print, in the following way.

1. Open the PDF file by Adobe Acrobat.
2. Choose “File” > “Print”.
3. Choose “Adobe PDF” from the list of printers in the print dialog box.
4. Click the button “Advanced” to open “Advanced Print Setup”.



- Set check off the check box “Use Maximum Available JPEG2000 Image Resolution”.



- Close the Advanced Print setup dialog, and click "Print" to use the Acrobat PDF printer.

- Click “OK” and enter a new file name for your PDF. Save to your desired location.

Then, the obtained PDF does not include jpeg2000 images and can be processed with InftyReader normally.
